



World heritage and intangible cultural heritage are two categories recognised by UNESCO for places, objects and traditions around the world with exceptional universal value.


With 19 sites and events recognised by UNESCO as examples of World Heritage, and one object on UNESCO's Memory of the World register, Hainaut Province holds a national record.

1998 / THE FOUR BOAT LIFTS ON THE CANAL DU CENTRE

The first site in Belgium recognised by UNESCO before the Grand Place in Brussels and the Flemish Béguinages!

Of the eight hydraulic boat lifts built at this time and at the beginning of the 20th century, the four lifts on the Canal du Centre are the only surviving examples in their original working order!

1999 / THE BINCHE BELFRY

Of the 56 belfries in Belgium and France included as one entry on the UNESCO World Heritage list, 5 can be found in Hainaut Province!

The Binche belfry, part of the town hall, was built in the 14th century. Burnt down by the French in 1554, the hall was soon restored in a Renaissance style by architect Du Broeucq. In the 18th century, the architect Dewelz covered the building with a neoclassical façade but, after major restoration works in 1901, the town hall regained its Renaissance appearance.

A Baroque onion-shaped dome crowns the belfry home to a carillon: a few of its bells date back to the 16th-century. Charles V and his sister Mary of Hungary's adorn the building.

Added to the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. Dating back to the Middle Ages, the famous Carnival of Binche is one of the oldest events of its kind that continues to this day in Europe!

2012 / BOIS-DU-LUC MINING SITE

Since I July 2012, 4 major mining sites in Wallonia have been on UNESCO's world heritage list. These are the best-preserved examples of coal mining sites, an activity that was common from the early 19th century until the second half of the 20th century.

Bois-du-Luc boasts a large number of buildings constructed between 1838 and 1909 as well as one of the oldest coalmines in Europe, dating back to the late $17^{\rm th}$ century.

One of the masterpieces of the "Park of Canals and Castles". Visible from tens of kilometres away in every direction, the tower of the Ronquières Inclined Plane not only boasts a stunning panorama, but is also the venue for an interactive experience, dedicated quite naturally, to canals, entitled "Un bateau, une vie..." (A boat, a life...). When it comes to technical feats, it is of course the inclined plane itself (two caissons on rails that go up and down a slope 1,500 metres long, changing height by around 70m) that will grab your attention. A real masterpiece, and a remarkable example of the use of concrete in architecture (by the same person who designed the Civil Engineering Arrow for Expo 58). Take the time to explore the Visitor Centre to watch the boats go by from the glass footbridges above the site, accessible via panoramic lifts.

Points-nœuds network (marked cycling network) in the Heart of Hainaut

This network of cycling itineraries in the Heart of Hainaut, covering 880km, will be connected to a group of "points-noeuds" cycling networks (marked cycling networks) which includes more than 46,000km of marked sections; the closest networks of Mons and of the Centre Region were already marked, or those of: Wallonie Picarde à Vélo and Brabant Wallon à Vélo.

Each intersection of the network is identified by a pointnœud (marker) number. The signs indicate the closest markers and the direction to follow to join them.

To prepare your itinerary, you only need to write down the list of markers that you want to pass, in the proper order, and then follow the numbered markers on land.

The network of "points-nœuds" will be available as early as July 2019.



LAND OF THE CARNIVAL LAND OF THE GILLES!

Gille is the symbolic character of the Carnival of Binche, but he is also present at all the carnivals in the Centre region.. Each municipality has since developed its own unique characteristics, gradually become quite distinct from the Carnival of Binche.

CARNIVAL OF BINCHE

23 > 25/02/2020

Each year, during the three days preceding Lent, it is host to carnival festivities that mobilize the historic centre and attract throngs of foreign visitors. With roots dating back to the Middle Ages, Binche's famed celebration ranks as one of Europe's oldest surviving street carnivals.

MORLANWELZ CARNIVAL «LE FEUREU» 01 > 02/03/2020 Le Feureu is one of the most stunning carnivals involving Gilles in the region. During the morning of the first Sunday in Lent, all the societies gather in the Grand'place to create a magnificent spectacle. For two whole days, the town celebrates. The high point of the Feureu Carnival takes place on Monday night, in the Place Albert 1st where the groups form a huge circle around a pyre.

LA LOUVIERE CARNIVAL

22 > 24/03/2020

Halfway through Lent, La Louvière wakes to the sound of drumming and the hammering of clogs: it's the Gilles. Dating back 150 years, the Laetare Carnival takes place in La Louvière, the city of wolves. The defining moment of Tuesday is the "brûlage des bosses" at 9pm: to symbolise the end of the carnival, an effigy dressed as Gille and stuffed with straw is burned.

CHAPELLE-LEZ-HERLAIMONT CARNIVAL

22 > 24/03/2020

The Chapelle Carnival has established quite a reputation for itself that has managed to cross the region's borders. On Laetare Monday, the fireworks create a fabulous pyrotechnic spectacle, the high point of the event known as "Prestige des Tchats", which is followed by several thousand spectators.

With more than 15,000 visitors over the course of the weekend, the "Salsiccia" festival has become the region's biggest Sicilian celebration.

NTERNATIONAL HOT AIR BALLOON CHALLENGE

(LE ROEULX)

EL CAUDIA IN BOIS-D'HAINE

ON THE TUESDAY AFTER THE LAST SUNDAY IN JUNE

The "Chaudeau" in Bois-d'Haine is a long-standing celebration whose origins date back to 14II. On the Tuesday after the last Sunday in June, a procession makes its way through the streets of the village to the sound of music. At sunset, the "chaudeau" (a milk soup with sugar and mastelle biscuits) is cooked in pots hanging from the horse chestnut tree in the Place Roi Baudouin. Once the "chaudeau" is ready, it is offered to the mayor and the parish priest before it is distributed to the people.

1st WEEKEND IN JULY

Attracting thousands of visitors each year, the "Weekend au bord de l'Eau" has become an unmissable event in La Louvière's calendar. At the beginning of July, visitors alike can enjoy a market of food and crafts, nautical fairground activities and a concert stage. Head along the towpath to Lift no. 3 to enjoy the street artists, family entertainment circus acts, musicians and creative workshops. RONQUIÈRES FESTIVAL (BRAINE-LE-COMTE)

1st WEEKEND IN AUGUST

In 7 years and a total of 210.000 festivalgoers have succumbed to the charm of this wonderful atmosphere and location, with fantastic concerts establishing the Ronquières Festival on the events calendar.



THE FORTIFICATIONS

Delightfully restored and lit up at night, with its 22 towers, today's fortifications in Binche date back to the 14th century. They replaced an older, smaller construction that protected the rocky spur to the south of Binche.

SAINT-URSMER COLLEGIATE CHURCH

The Moustier Sainte-Marie, a primitive building, was built in the Roman style in the 12th century. In 1408, the Lobbes chapter came to Binche with its holy relics and treasures, and the collegiate church dedicated to Saint Ursmer was built.

"LA BINCHOISF" ARTISAN BREWERY

The history of the Brasserie dates back to 1847.In 1929, the site was bought by Oscar Roulez, a maltster, who knocked down the old brewery and built the current buidings. In 1979, André Graux installed the Brasserie La Binchoise. Since 2000, the brewery has been open to the public. You can go on a guided tour as well as taking part in beer tasting sessions.

BOIS DE LA HOUSSIERE

Braine-le-Comte boasts one of the most remarkable wooded areas in Hainaut, an expanse of over 650 hectares whose existence can be explained by the tall mound of Lutetian sand (with a 160m summit) marking the boundary between the Bainette Valley and the Sennette Valley.

IRON MAN

The Survey marker (nicknamed Iron man) can be found at the southernmost point of the wood. It contributed to the map of Belgium in the XIXth century, made with the help of the principle of triangulation. It was later used to calculate latitude/logitude, altitude and force of gravity. It remains a reminder of our history and the ingenuity of our ancestors.

WALKING AND CYCLING IN BRAINE-LE-COMTE

The landscape around Braine-Le-Comte is incredibly diverse and a wonderful area to explore; walks in the forest, mountain biking through the countryside, a stroll along the canal, a bike ride taking in the local heritage... Nature is one of our greatest assets, and some sites are listed so well worth a visit.

THE ECAUSSINNES-LALAING FORTIFIED CASTLE AND GARDEN

Built in the 12th century by Count Baudouin V of Hainaut, the Ecaussinnes-Lalaing fortified castle is a stunning example of medieval architecture that has been passed down through the centuries to the present day.

THE 14-18 AND 40-45 WAR MUSEUM

For more than 30 years, Raymond Maucq collected everything that could relate to the 14-18 war, but even more so the 40-45 war. You'll find an impressive and incredibly diverse collection of objects that were used during the war, the end of which marked the freedom of Europe and the beginning of its Union.

LE GOÛTER MATRIMONIAL

Every year at Pentecost, a whole population mobilizes and relives the tradition of the «Goûter Matrimonial», initiated by Marcel Tricot in 1903.

BONNE-ESPÉRANCE ABBEY

Founded in II30 by the canons of the Ordre of Prémontré, the Norbertine Bonne-Espérance Abbey, located in the municipality of Vellereille-les-Brayeux, in Estinnes, is the only one in Hainaut to have been preserved from the ravages of the French revolution. As it stands today, it is a remarkable example of 18th century architecture.

THE WINDMILL PARK

Modern-day windmills now tower over the Estinnes countryside. Eleven wind turbines, each one 198m tall, regarded as the most powerful onshore wind turbines in the world.

AGAISES VINEYARD

The Agaises vineyard can be found in the municipality of Estinnes, a few kilometres East of Binche. More than 180,000 vines are planted on 18 hectares, making Agaises the biggest wine producer in Belgium. The traditional production method, using Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes, has produced plaudits for a number of Seigneur Ruffus champagnes.

THE ST-FEUILLIEN BREWERY

In the 7th century, an Irish monk called Feuillien came to the continent to preach the Gospel. Unfortunately, in 655, he was attacked and decapitated. His disciples built a chapel which, in 1125, became a Norbertine Abbey: the Abbaye de Saint-Feuillien du Roeulx. Up until the French Revolution, the abbey prospered, and monks brewed beer there. Founded in 1873 by Stéphanie Friart, Saint-Feuillien Brewery keeps the memory of the abbey alive today.

Thieu Marina is on the historical canal of the Centre Region (350 tonnes), not far from Boat Lift no. 4.

MARIEMONT PARK

Mariemont Park is one of the most beautiful parks in Belgium. It covers around 45 hectares, as well as its driveway, "Drève de Mariemont". It looks the same as it would have done at the beginning of the 20th century. Designed according to models of English gardens of that time, with lawn, lakes, winding paths and foliage, the park also have a number of trees that are over a hundred years old.

MARIEMONT WOOD

Mariemont wood covers around 150 hectares and is part of the Mariemont Estate. It is mainly made up of neutrophile beech, oak and hornbeam trees. When it comes to heritage, the wood contains many reminders of the region's mining past. Mineshafts, rail tunnels, remnants of the railway and man-made ravines and embankments are just some of the traces of coal mining still visible today.

MONTAIGU PRIORY

Along with the Notre-Dame Chapel in Saint-Sang, Montaigu Priory is one of the last witnesses of Morlanwelz's past that is still standing today. A contemporary of the Royal Castle of the Archdukes Albert and Isabelle, an iconic local monument, it is only natural that it has become a cultural venue for the area, even if originally it would have seemed unlikely that it would end up with such a profane vocation.

LOUVIGNIES CASTLE

A real treasure trove, this charming romantic castle, a typical example of 19th architecture, houses memories of daily life during the Belle Epoque. The guided tour will take you through formal living rooms, bedrooms where chatelaines used to get ready. The kitchen is a real treat and has been used as the set for films including Claude Berry's "Germinal" and François Ozon's "Angel".

SAINT-VINCENT COLLEGIATE CHURCH

Soignies, a town with Medieval origins, lived for almost 9 centuries to the rhythm of the Canons of SaintVincent, who built an imposing Collegiate church here in the 11th century. The primitive Roman style, with its tall rubble stone walls and two imposing towers, give the building a strength, majesty and elegance.

BLUE STONE DOCUMENTATION CENTRE

Soignies, European Center of the Blue Stone, makes the international fame of the city. Discover the grandiose spectacle of the men bustling at the bottom of the quarries and maneuvering mechanical monsters in the roar of roaring engines and the clatter of the chains that hoist the huge limestone blocks. Tour of the working quarry's installations with the guide.


